BYSTANDER INTERVENTION

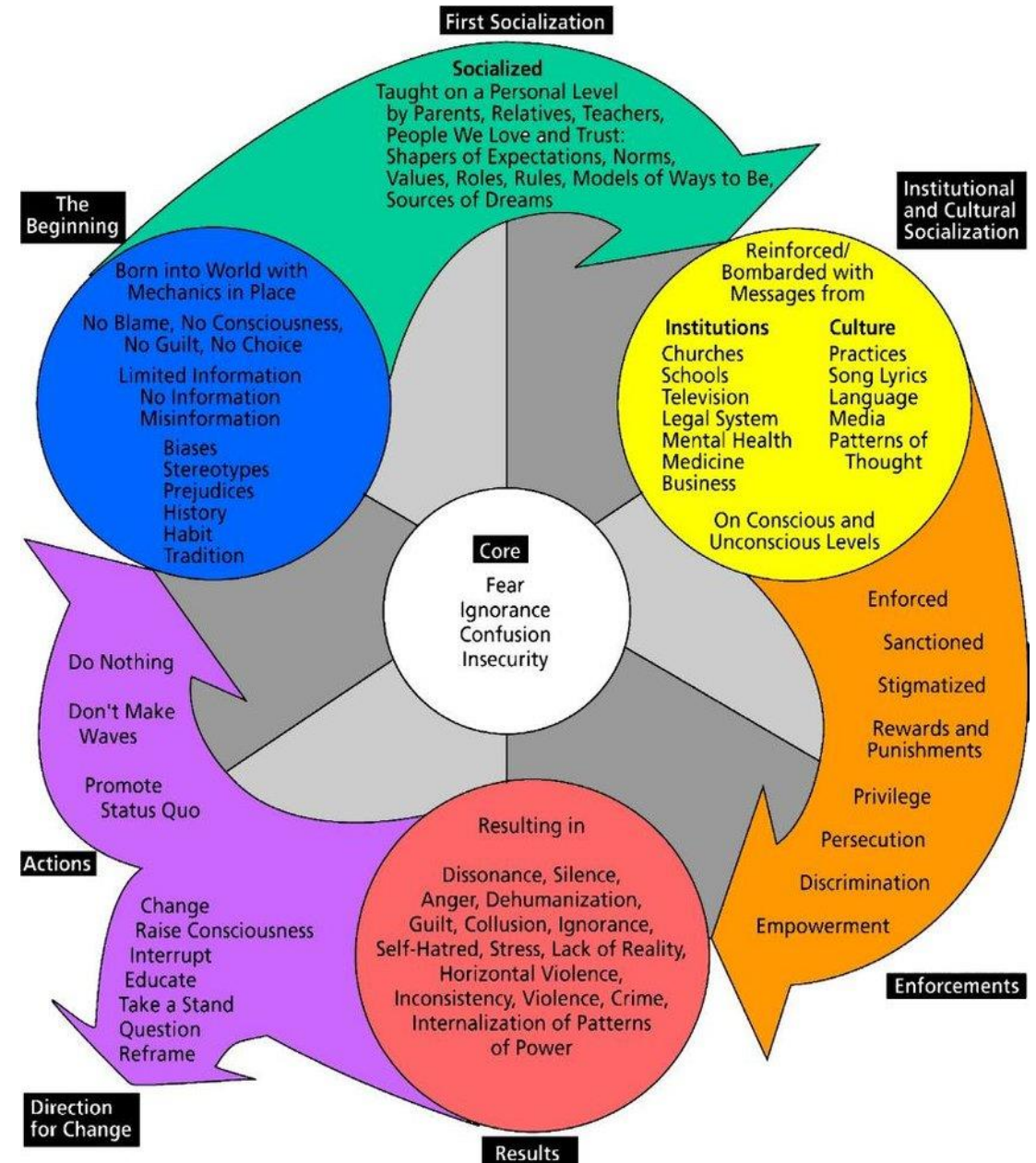
A **bystander** is a person who is present, but not involved or does not take part in an incident.

If bystanders intervene **effectively and safely**, they may be able to diffuse a situation that could lead to sexual violence.

BYSTANDER EFFECT

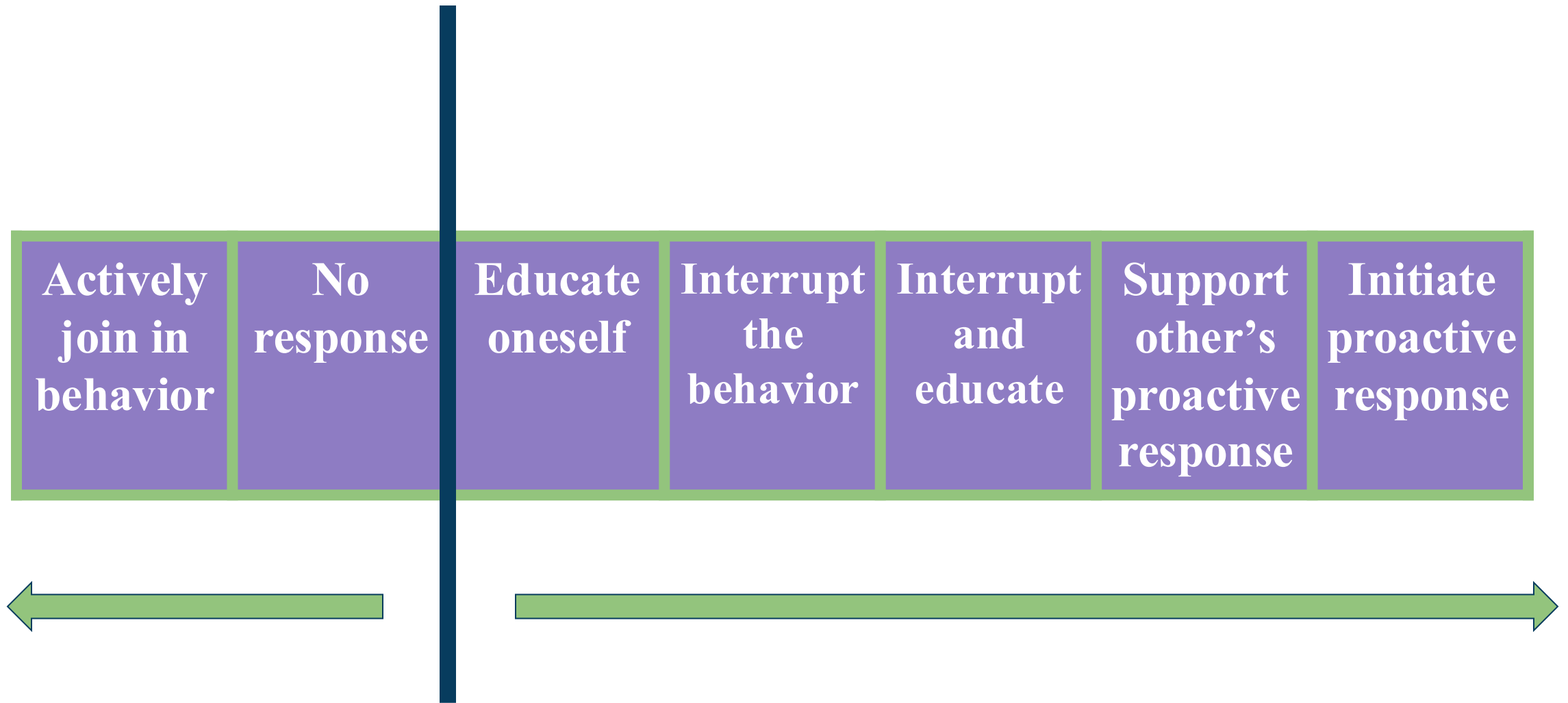


CYCLE OF SOCIALIZATION

THINK, PAIR, SHARE

An Opportunity To Chat With Your Neighbors

- **Third**.....share out with the larger group.



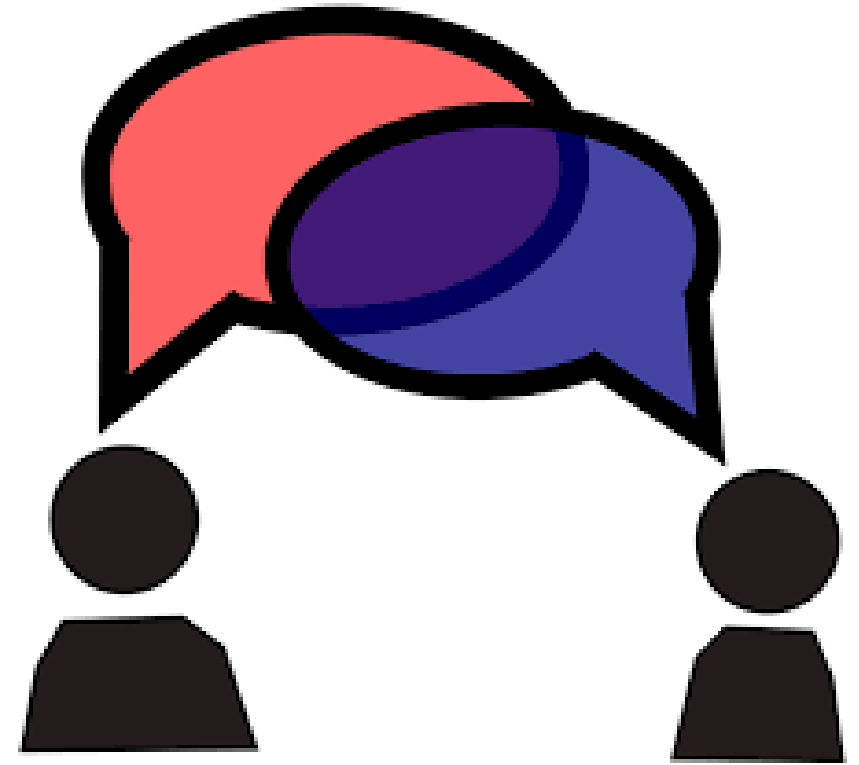
- Direct

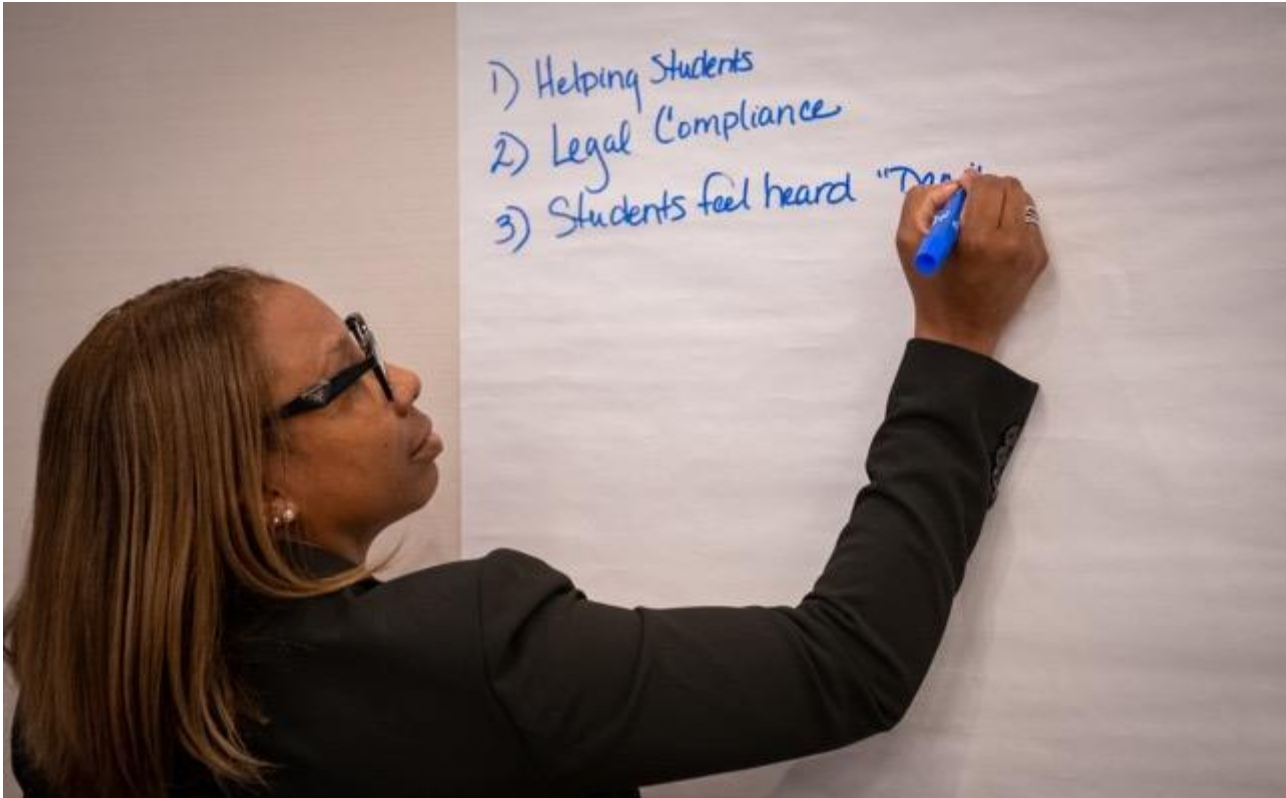

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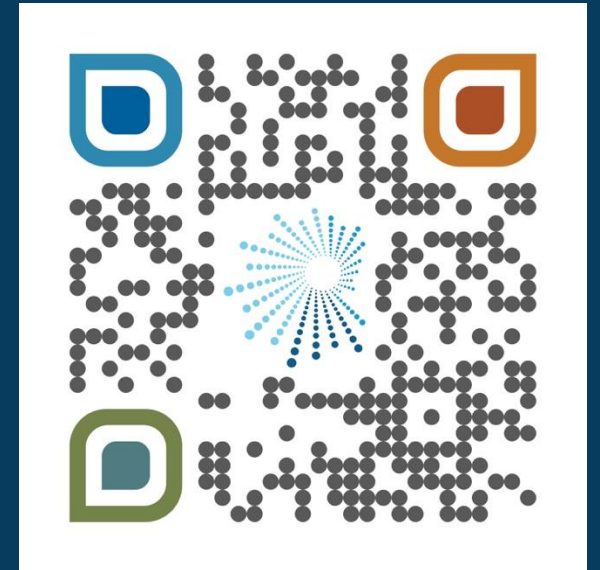
