- Evaluate students in classroom, clinical, and lab settings.
- Maintain regular communication with students regarding their progress.
- Keep accurate student academic records.
- Ensure course outcomes are met.
- Contribute to course development, accreditation activities, and program assessments.
- Prepare and teach College-approved courses, including syllabi, reading lists, and up-to-date course content.
- Hold regular office hours.
- Participate in admissions events and recruitment activities.
- Conduct research and publish per tenure track requirements.
- Collaborate effectively with diverse faculty, staff, and students.
- Demonstrate strong oral and written communication skills and proficiency in Microsoft Office.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Nursing Department Chairperson.
